



The Indiana Municipal Power Agency (IMPA) and Energizing Indiana are now offering a program to increase Huntingburg's energy efficiency while simultaneously raising funds for the city's nonprofit organizations. The City of Huntingburg has partnered with the Huntingburg Housing Authority (HHA) to promote Energizing Indiana's Community Outreach Enrichment program.

This program enlists nonprofit organizations like HHA to sign up residents who live in an IMPA member community or who are served by an investor-owned electric utility for Energizing Indiana's home energy assessment. For every resident who signs up through HHA and completes an Energizing Indiana home energy assessment (at no additional cost), the nonprofit organization will receive \$25, up to \$25,000 per program year.

HHA provides housing to Huntingburg low-income families, elderly and the disabled. The organization plans to use funds raised through this program to make energy efficiency upgrades and to promote recycling. "I truly hope members of our community will take advantage of this program," HHA Executive Director Heidi Reller said. "By signing up, they are making a donation to HHA that will not cost them anything and they will receive a tremendous benefit themselves by improving their home's performance, reducing energy bills, improving air quality and increasing their home's value."

During a home energy assessment, an Energizing Indiana energy advisor will assess the heating, ventilation and air conditioning systems in the home to determine operating efficiency. The home energy assessment may include energy saving measures such as:

- Replacing up to nine traditional light bulbs with compact fluorescent lights (CFLs).
- Installing up to three low-flow faucet aerators.
- Installing up to two low-flow shower heads.



Once a home's energy assessment is complete, the resident will receive a comprehensive report detailing what can be done to start saving energy and make their home more comfortable.
