

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY
Thursday, October 3, 2013
8:30 A.M.

The Board of Public Works & Safety of the City of Huntingburg met in regular session on Thursday, October 3, 2013 at the hour of 8:30 A.M. in the Council Chambers of the Huntingburg City Hall with members Spinner, Souders and Cox present. Also present was City Attorney Schneider.

Mayor Spinner called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Spinner, seconded by Cox and carried to approve the minutes of the September 5, 2013 meeting.

A motion was made by Cox, seconded by Souders and carried to approve the claims as presented.

Fire Chief Patberg presented his monthly report. He informed the Board that Bradley Buechler passed his skills tests.

Wastewater Superintendent Kemp presented his monthly report. He requested permission to seek quotes for a new loader. He indicated that their current loader is a 2007 model, still in good shape but is in need of new tires.

A motion was made by Spinner, seconded by Souders and carried to approve seeking quotes for the purchase and lease of a new skid loader for the Wastewater Utility with a trade-in of a 2007 skid loader and also to seek quotes on tires for the current 2007 loader.

Police Chief Parks presented his monthly report. Parks noted that he is going to purchase some needle containers for the vehicles and he indicated that he will be purchasing 11, 40 Cal. Glock compact handguns. He informed the Board that two officers were injured in knife training held on September 19, 2013.

Street Superintendent Stamm presented his monthly report. He informed the Board the finished surface will be left off of 10th Street until next year due to anticipated truck traffic of the next phase of the project.

Stamm indicated that there is a dire need for a new tractor to do brush hogging and side-arm mowing. He suggests trading two mowers in and getting one mower that can do both jobs.

A motion was made by Cox, seconded by Souders and carried to seek quotes for a mower for the street department.

Stamm requested permission to attend 1 of 3 days of the Midwest Damage Prevention Conference in French Lick.

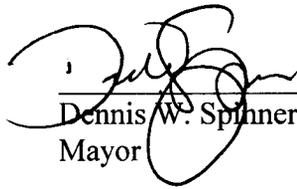
A motion was made by Spinner, seconded by Cox and carried to approve Stamm attending 1 day of the Midwest Damage Prevention Conference in French Lick, Indiana.

Code Enforcement Officer Collett presented his monthly report. Collett updated the Board that he has been in contact with Charles Mendel about the property at 406 E. 1st Avenue in Huntingburg, Indiana and that Mr. Mendel is aware of the dates to vacate and other points of the order.

Attorney Schneider presented a proposed inter-local agreement between the City of Huntingburg and Dubois County for sharing local costs of the proposed railroad overpass. The agreement is for the County to pay half of the 20% local share up to \$1,000,000 and the City to pay half the local share.

A motion was made by Cox, seconded by Souders and carried to approve the inter-local agreement between the City of Huntingburg and Dubois County as presented.

There being no further business to come before the Board, a motion to adjourn was made by Cox, seconded by Souders and carried at 9:05 A.M.
