

**BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY**  
**Thursday, June 5, 2014**  
**8:30 A.M.**

The Board of Public Works & Safety of the City of Huntingburg met in regular session on Thursday, June 5, 2014 at the hour of 8:30 A.M. in the Council Chambers of the Huntingburg City Hall with members Spinner, Souders and Cox present. Also present was City Attorney Schneider.

Mayor Spinner called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Cox, seconded by Souders and carried to approve the minutes of the May 1, 2014 meeting.

A motion was made by Spinner, seconded by Cox and carried to approve the claims as presented.

Shane Lindauer was present representing the St. Anthony Sesqui-Centennial Bike Ride and submitted a Special Event Permit Application for the portion of the ride through Huntingburg to be held on August 16, 2014. They will be required to put warning signs in the City.

A motion was made by Spinner, seconded by Souders and carried to approve the Special Event Permit Application noted above.

Gary Bender was present to request approval of the Special Event Permit Application for the YMI for their annual car show to be held in the City parking lot on July 4, 2014 from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.

A motion was made by Cox, seconded by Souders and carried to approve the Special Event Permit Application as presented by the YMI.

Clerk-Treasurer Dippel swore in Josh Hemmer and Paula Hemmer as Huntingburg Volunteer Firefighters.

Fire Chief Patberg presented his monthly report. He noted that ladder testing will be going on June 23-24, 2014.

Wastewater Superintendent Kemp presented his monthly report.

Police Chief Parks presented his monthly report. He noted that the list of possible reserves is now down to 4 from 11.

Street Superintendent Stamm presented his monthly report. He presented four quotes for pothole patch machine. He recommended the low quote from CPMG (Dura Patch) in the amount of \$55,166.10. He noted the similarity in the machines.

A motion was made by Cox, seconded by Souders and carried to approve the purchase of the Dura Patch pothole machine from CPMG as recommended in the amount of \$55,166.10.


Stamm informed the Board of the bids received to sell the 1978 trash truck. The only bid received was from Velpen Disposal in the amount of \$2,500.00.


A motion was made by Spinner, seconded by Souders and carried to accept the bid of Velpen Disposal for the 1978 trash truck.
