

## **Public Notice of Rights Under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 Huntingburg Transit System**

The Huntingburg Transit System operates its programs and services without regard to race, color, and national origin in accordance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964. Any person who believes he or she has been aggrieved by any unlawful discriminatory practice under Title VI may file a complaint with the Huntingburg Transit System.

The complaint should be submitted by the grievant and/or his/her designate as soon as possible but no later than 30 calendar days after the alleged violation to:
