A motion was made by Cox, seconded by Lewallen and carried to approve the minutes of the March 1, 2012 meeting.

Police Chief Parks introduced Andrew Hammack to the Board. Parks requested that Hammack be approved for hire as a police officer.

A motion was made by Spinner, seconded by Lewallen and carried to approve hiring Andrew Hammack as a police officer.


Clerk-Treasurer Dippel administered the oath of office to new Police Officer, Andrew Hammack.



A motion was made by Spinner, seconded by Cox and carried to approve offering Brad Kramer a conditional offer of employment as a 1st Class Police Officer.
