

**HUNTINGBURG REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION**  
**Minutes of the Monday, October 8, 2012 Meeting**

The Huntingburg Redevelopment Commission met in session on October 1, 2012 at 7:00 P.M. at the Huntingburg City Hall. Members present were Bob Fowler, Jim Heidorn, Joe Bartelt, and Rich Hazlewood. Eugene Peters was absent.

The minutes of the July 18, 2012 minutes were read and approved as submitted. A motion to approve the minutes as submitted was made by Joe Bartelt. The motion was seconded by Rich Hazlewood. The motion was approved 4-0 by the Commissioners.

Rich Hazlewood requested the approval of the hiring of Rudolph & Co., Inc. for the milling and repaving of Phoenix Drive (400S), from 400 W to US 231, including shoulder stone, centerline stripe, thermo stop bar, and stop & speed limit signs. The costs are based upon the Huntingburg 2012 Supply Bid. The cost is anticipated to be \$ 249,000. The motion to approve this project was made by Joe Bartelt and seconded by Jim Heidorn. The motion was approved 4-0 by the Commissioners. This is a fund 53 expense.

Rich Hazlewood requested the approval of the Chestnut Street project cost-of-repairs to the Dennis Able property. The street department will make the necessary repairs to his yard/drainage. The estimated costs are \$3,800.85. With a 10% contingency, please approve \$ 4,200.00 for this repair. This is a fund 52 expense. The motion to approve this project was made by Jim Heidorn and seconded by Joe Bartelt. The motion was approved 4-0 by the Commissioners.

The next meeting will be determined later.
