Job Summary

• This full-time position reports to and receives direct supervision from the Street Superintendent and/or Street Lead Person.

Basic requirements include the following, but are not limited to:

- Must be at least eighteen (18) years of age
- Must possess a valid Indiana Operator's License and demonstrate a safe driving record
- Must be able to obtain a Commercial Drivers License within 90 days of employment
- Ability to operate various types of heavy equipment including dump truck, loader, limb chipper, jack hammer, leaf vac, etc.
- Ability to stand or walk for long periods of time
- Must be able to safely lift 50lbs.
- Ability to follow all necessary safety precautions
- Ability to be on 24-hour on-call in case of extreme emergencies
- Ability to occasionally work extended weekend and/or evening hours

Job duties include the following, but are not limited to:

- Repair potholes in streets
- Pour concrete
- Clean storm drains, sewers, and culverts
- Paint curbs, crosswalks, signs, and traffic control lines
- Replace damaged or fallen signs and reflectors
- Trim around hedges, signs, and cuts down and removes dead trees
- Collect and dispose of trash, debris, and dead animals along city streets
- Haul gravel, blacktop or oil to construction sites and assist in spreading
- Act as flagger along city streets to warn motorists of road construction detours or emergencies
- Respond to public complaints/inquiries as assigned
