3. Director's Report:
  - A. General:
    - a. 3rd Playground presentation for Northside Park
    - b. Mike Uebelhor - wants to know if they can park the Peaches bus at the entrance to park. Park board will access the location.
    - c. Bombers - would like to enlarge the gift shop at League Stadium
    - d. The park department is going to cut some dead trees down at Memorial Park.
    - e. **Emily Finch SWCD Invasive Species Specialist**  
Serving Dubois, Daviess, & Martin Counties - would like to spend a day next spring with the park employees and volunteers to identify, remove, and start a continuation to rid the park system of invasive plants. The board was fine with going forward with it.

  - F. League Stadium:
    - a. Project - to concrete east of concession stand - beer area - drainage

I. Southside Park:





- a. The restroom is closed for the winter
