This made it the only state to secede from a Confederate state during the war. The building is now a state-run museum, housing exhibits on West Virginia history. From here you will continue to Wheeling Island Racetrack & Gaming Center where you will receive a bonus package with Players Club Card

registration. You will have an opportunity to try your hand at the games of chance in the casino and pick the winning greyhounds (based on availability.) There will be plenty of time to enjoy the complex and dinner is on your own at the casino.
