

**UTILITY BOARD/COMMON COUNCIL**

**Tuesday, February 11, 2020**

The Common Council and Utility Board of the City of Huntingburg met in joint session at the regularly scheduled meeting time on Tuesday, February 11, 2020 at the hour of 5:30 P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Huntingburg City Hall at 508 E. Fourth Street, Huntingburg, Indiana. Members Dubon, Bounds, Kissling, McPherron and Wehr were present. Also present were Mayor Spinner, City Attorney Schneider and Clerk-Treasurer Dippel.

Mayor Spinner called the meeting to order.

A motion was made by Bounds, seconded by Kissling and carried to approve the minutes of the January 28, 2020 meeting.


A motion was made by Kissling, seconded by Wehr and carried to approve the claims as presented.

Clerk Treasurer Dippel presented a list of delinquent utility bill accounts in the amount of \$18,439.93. Dippel also informed the Board that estimated recovery in the first two weeks of this year's Tax Refund Exchange and Compliance System (TRECS), Indiana income tax refund offset program, is approximately \$8,200.00.

A motion was made by Kissling, seconded by McPherron and carried to approve the write-off of the utility account balances as presented.

The Mayor presented documents from the National League of Cities concerning blocking of railroad crossings by railroad companies. He noted the efforts being done to minimize blockages and informed the Council of ways to report blockages to the Federal Railroad Administration.

There being no further business before the Council, a motion was made by Wehr, seconded by Kissling and carried to adjourn the meeting at 5:50 o'clock P.M.
