**ORDINANCE NO. 2018- 05**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2016-27**  
**ESTABLISHING A NET METERING PROGRAM AND**  
**TARIFF FOR THE CITY OF HUNTINGBURG ELECTRIC UTILITY**

WHEREAS, the City of Huntingburg, Indiana, has heretofore adopted Ordinance No. 2016-27 establishing a net metering program and tariff for use by electric utility customers who own and operate a single phase renewable electric generation source; and

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Huntingburg now determines that the net metering program should extend to all eligible residential and commercial customers, in order to encourage the use of renewable energy resources and renewable energy technologies as well as to promote the wise use of Indiana's natural energy resources to meet growing electricity demand.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Huntingburg, Indiana, as follows:

**Section 1.** Ordinance No. 2016-27 is hereby amended by restating Section 3 thereof as follows:

**Section 3** "Eligible Net Metering Customers" include any customer in good standing that owns and operates a renewable generating facility that: (a) has a name plate capacity less than or equal to ten (10) kilowatts (kW) for Residential Class customers, or less than or equal to thirty (30) kilowatts (kW) for Commercial and Small Industrial Class customers; (b) is located on the customer's premises and is operated by the customer; and (c) is used primarily to offset all or part of the customer's own electricity requirements. An Eligible Net Metering Customer is limited to one (1) generation interconnection service location.

**Section 2.** The "net metering tariff" heretofore adopted by Ordinance No. 2016-27 is hereby amended and restated to permit residential and commercial/small industrial customers as "eligible net metering customers" in accordance with Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.


**Section 3.** All other provisions of Ordinance No. 2016-27 not in conflict herewith shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council and approval by the Mayor.




