

**COMMON COUNCIL
SPECIAL SESSION
Thursday, October 1, 2020
5:45 P.M.**

The Common Council of the City of Huntingburg met in special session on Thursday, October 1, 2020 at the hour of 5:45 P.M. in the Council Chambers of the Huntingburg City Hall at 508 E. Fourth Street, Huntingburg, Indiana. Members Bounds, Kissling, McPherron and Dubon were physically present. Member Wehr participated in this meeting by electronic communication by which he was able to simultaneously communicate. Also present were Mayor Spinner, City Attorney Schneider and Clerk-Treasurer Dippel.


Mayor Spinner called the meeting to order at 6:15 P.M. , due to the Executive Session lasting longer than scheduled. A roll call was taken; all members were present.

The Mayor indicated that there is only one item on the agenda. He noted that the City is involved in a litigation suite at this time and there was a mediation hearing on September 24, 2020, and the terms of the mediation were discussed by the Council in Executive session.


The Mayor asked if there is any motion on the floor from the Council concerning the mediation as discussed.
