

**BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS & SAFETY
SPECIAL MEETING
Wednesday, September 15, 2021
8:30 A.M.**

The Board of Public Works & Safety of the City of Huntingburg met in special session on Wednesday, September 15, 2021 at the hour of 8:30 A.M. in the Council Chambers of the Huntingburg City Hall with members Schmett, Schwinghamer and Souders present. Also present was Deputy Clerk-Treasurer Stevens. Member Blessinger and Attorney Schneider were absent.

Mayor Schwinghamer called the special meeting to order.

Mayor Schwinghamer introduced a new Board Member, Dan Fitch, who will replace Neil Elkins starting in October 2021.

The Mayor informed the Board that the Common Council approved the ordinance reducing the speed limit on Progress Parkway to 25 mph.

He also presented an agreement with Indiana Department of Transportation for guide signs to be installed and maintained on US 231 and SR 64 for the railroad bypass signs.

A motion was made by Schmett, seconded by Souders and carried to accept the agreement as presented.

Chad Trent and Sarah Flamion, representing Huntingburg Heritage, requested approval for the Herbstfest Parade Route to start on Van Buren Street, West on 3rd Street to Geiger Street, South on Geiger Street to 1st Street, then East on 1st Street ending at the Huntingburg City Park.

A motion was made by Schwinghamer, seconded by Souders and carried to accept the Herbstfest Parade Route as requested.

Street Superintendent Stamm informed the Board of the Fall Clean-up scheduled, which is:


Thursday	October 7, 2021 from 1:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M.

Saturday	October 9, 2021 from 8:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.


Stamm noted the prices will be the same as last time.
