Street Department/Laborer Position

- This full-time position reports to and receives direct supervision from the Street Superintendent and/or Street Lead Person.
- This position functions as a laborer in the street department and assists in accomplishing various work duties including but not limited to:
 - * Performs work in crew worker capacity in the operations of Street Department.
 - * Drives vehicles to and from assigned locations.
 - * Assists with and/or performs loading or unloading vehicle.
 - * Repairs potholes in streets.
 - * Pours concrete
 - * Cleans storm drains, sewers and culverts.
 - * Paints curbs, crosswalks, signs and traffic control lines.
 - * Replaces damaged or fallen signs and reflectors.
 - * Trims around hedges, signs and cuts down and removes dead trees.
 - * Collects and disposes of trash, debris and dead animals along city streets.
 - * Hauls gravel, blacktop or oil to construction sites and assist in spreading.
 - * Acts as flagger along city streets to warn motorists of road construction detours or emergencies.
 - * May operate various types of street department equipment including pickup trucks, dump trucks, loaders, limb chipper, jack hammer, etc.
 - * Must be able to obtain Commercial Drivers License within 90 days of employment
 - * Ability to be on 24-hour on-call in case of extreme emergencies.
 - * Ability to occasionally work extended weekend and/or evening hours.
