**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2013-35
TO ADJUST RATES AND CHARGES FOR THE ELECTRIC UTILITY
TO REFLECT THE REPEAL OF THE UTILITY RECEIPTS TAX
BY HEA 1002-2022**

WHEREAS, the current schedule of rates and charges for use of and services rendered by the municipally owned electric utility were established by Ordinance No. 2013-35 adopted December 12, 2013, and include the recovery of the Indiana Utility Receipts Tax heretofore imposed by I.C. 6-2.3 *et seq.*; and

WHEREAS, by HEA 1002-2022, the Indiana General Assembly has repealed the Indiana Utility Receipts Tax, and has mandated that every utility whose rates and charges include the recovery of the Indiana Utility Receipts Tax, adjust its rates and charges to reflect the repeal of said tax; and

WHEREAS, the City has retained O. W. Krohn & Associates, CPA to calculate the rate adjustment necessary to remove the amount of the Utility Receipts Tax from City's municipally owned electric utility rates and charges; and

WHEREAS, the adjustment to the rates and charges necessary to remove recovery of the Utility Receipts Tax has been calculated by O. W. Krohn & Associates, CPA, and is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Common Council of the City of Huntingburg, Indiana, as follows:

Section 1. The schedule of rates and charges for use of and services rendered by the municipally owned electric utility established by Ordinance No. 2013-35 adopted December 12, 2013, is hereby adjusted and amended by removing the recovery of the Indiana Utility Receipts Tax, as set out in Exhibit "A" attached hereto, and made a part hereof.

Section 2. The rates and charges for use of and services rendered by the municipally owned electric utility as set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto are hereby adopted effective July 1, 2022.


Section 3. The utility shall provide notice to all affected customers in each of the two (2) billing cycles following the effective date of the rate adjustment, that the adjustment reflects the repeal of the Utility Receipts Tax by the general assembly, and the amount of the adjustment.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council, approval by the Mayor, and publication as required by law.




